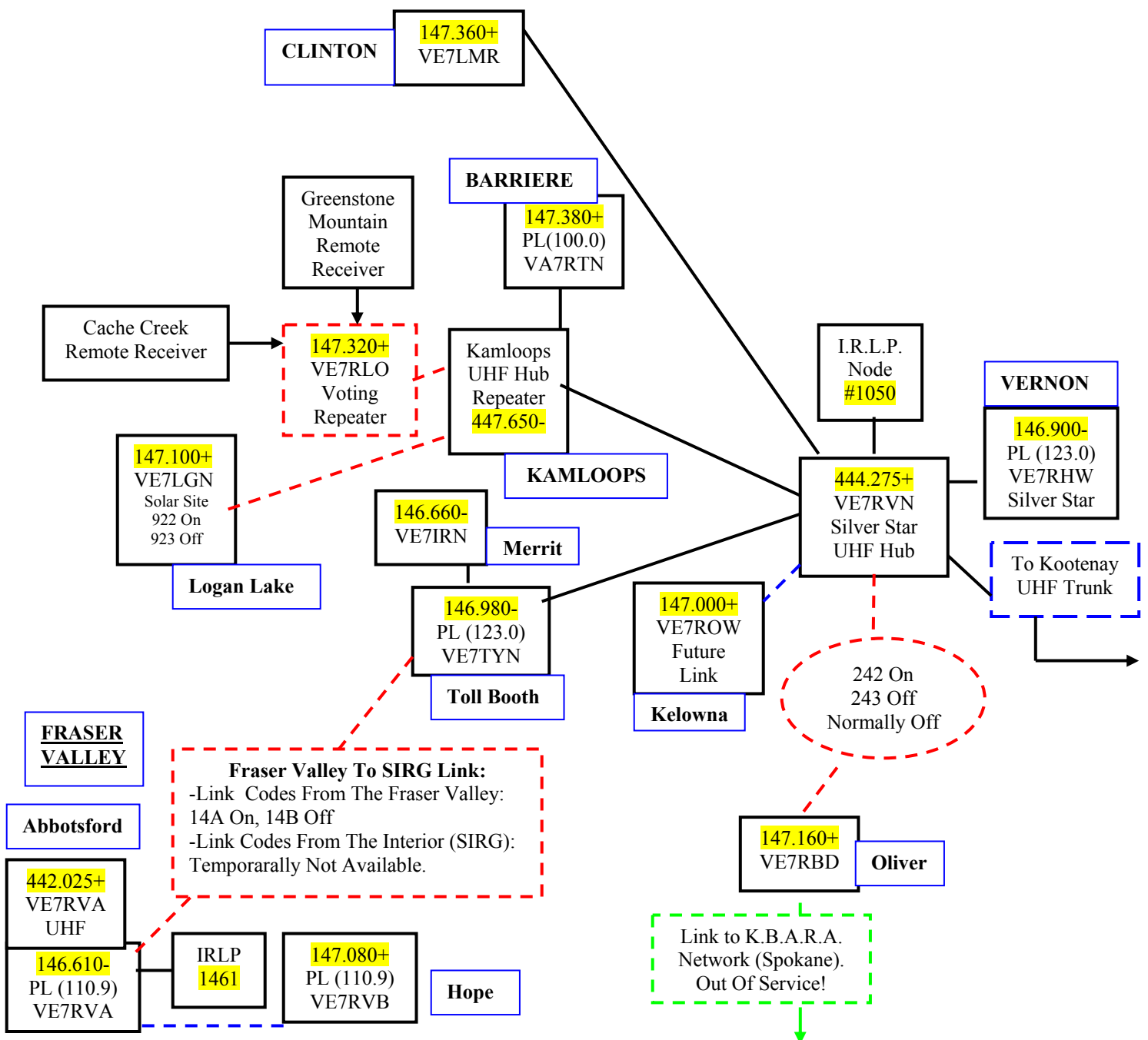


**Southern Interior Repeater Group (SIRG) Linked Amateur Repeaters:**

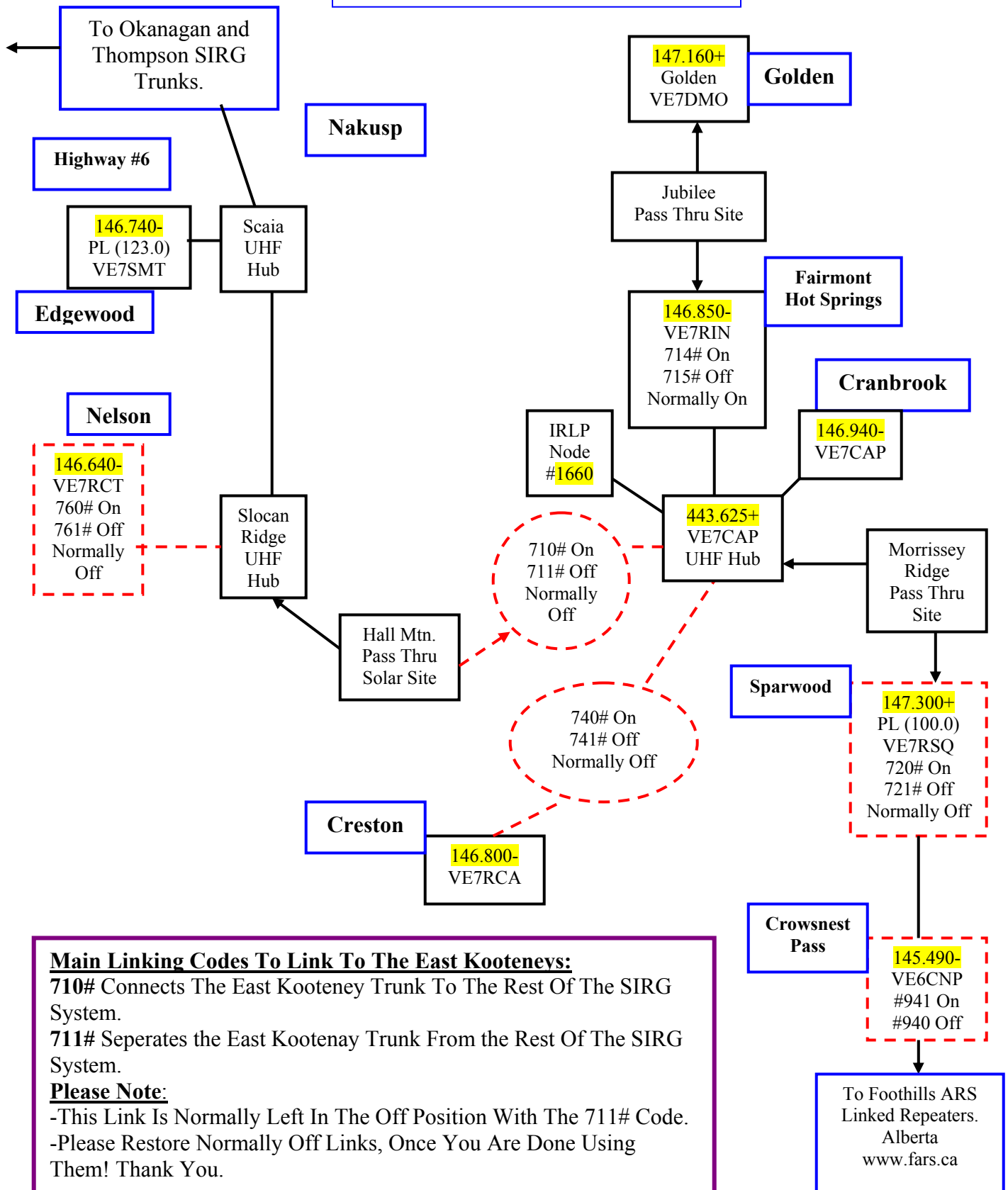
**Key:**

- RED** Dotted Lines Are Links Or Repeaters That Are Normally Not Linked To The SIRG Trunk.
- BLACK** Solid Lines Are Links And Repeaters That Are Normally Left On The SIRG Trunk.
- Box's Indicate Local Repeater Information.
- Circles Indicate Link Switch Information.
- Green** Boxes Announce Future or Down Links & Repeaters.
- BLUE** Boxes Contain Local Area Information.

Please ID When Turning On Or Off Various Links.  
When Done. Restore Links Back To There Proner State.

**Main Linking Codes To Link To The East Kootenays:**

**710#** Connects The East Kootenay Trunk To The Rest Of The SIRG System.

**711#** Separates the East Kootenay Trunk From the Rest Of The SIRG System.

- This Link Is Normally Left In The Off Position With The 711# Code.
- Please Restore Normally Off Links, Once You Are Done Using Them! Thank You.
